



A digging tool for making holes in dirt, with a long wood handle and a flat blade, often reinforced along the edge with a metal spade-iron.

Default orientation: handle to chief. Proper coloration: brown wood.

A shovel is similar to a spade, but optimized for scooping, and differentiated by its square blade.
