

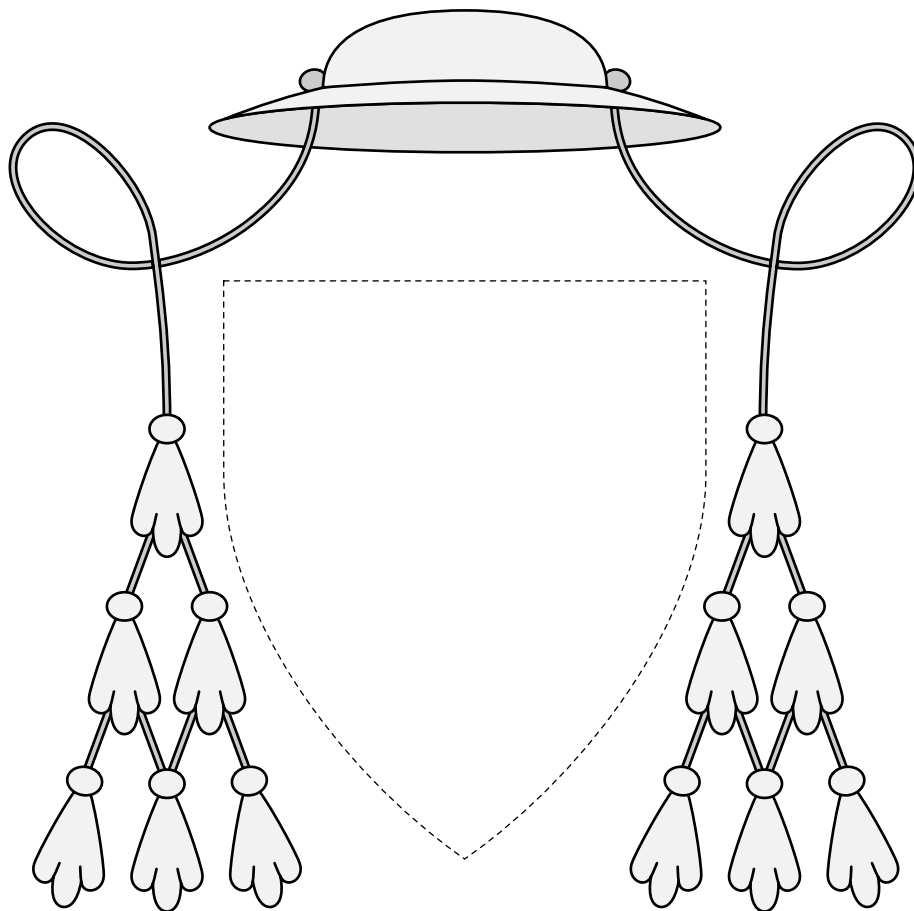

The arms of clergy were typically displayed beneath a hat rather than a war-like helm.

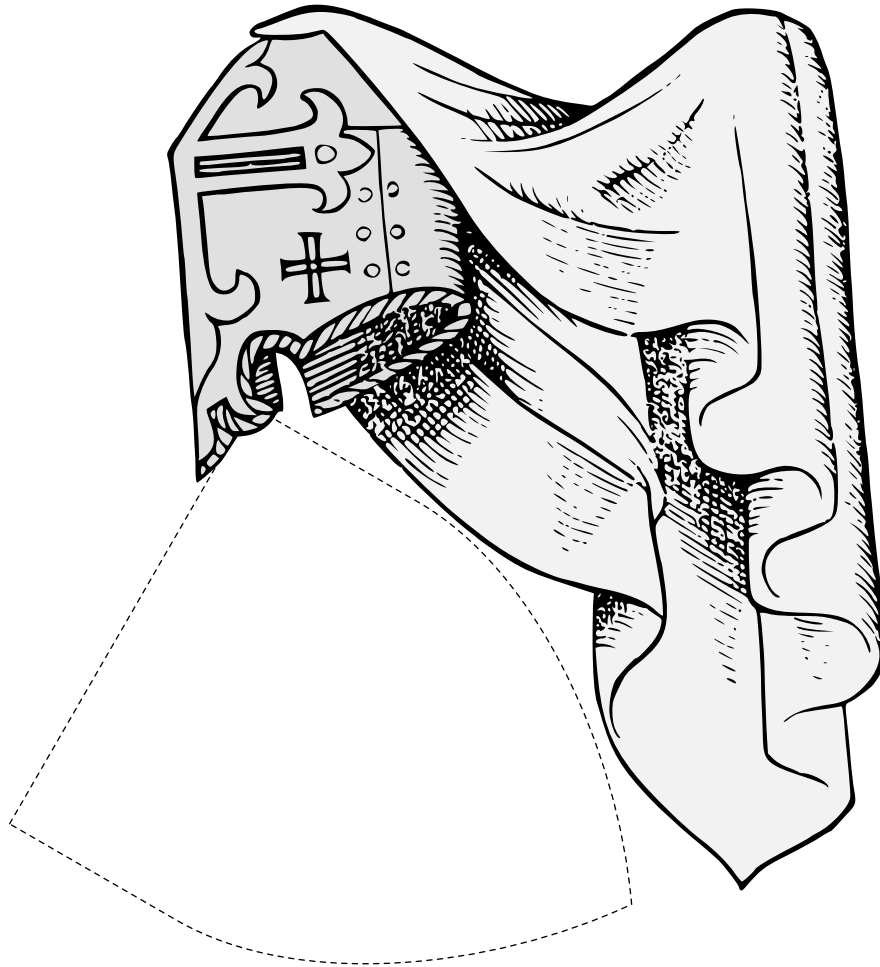
The number of tassels is increased as a sign of rank.

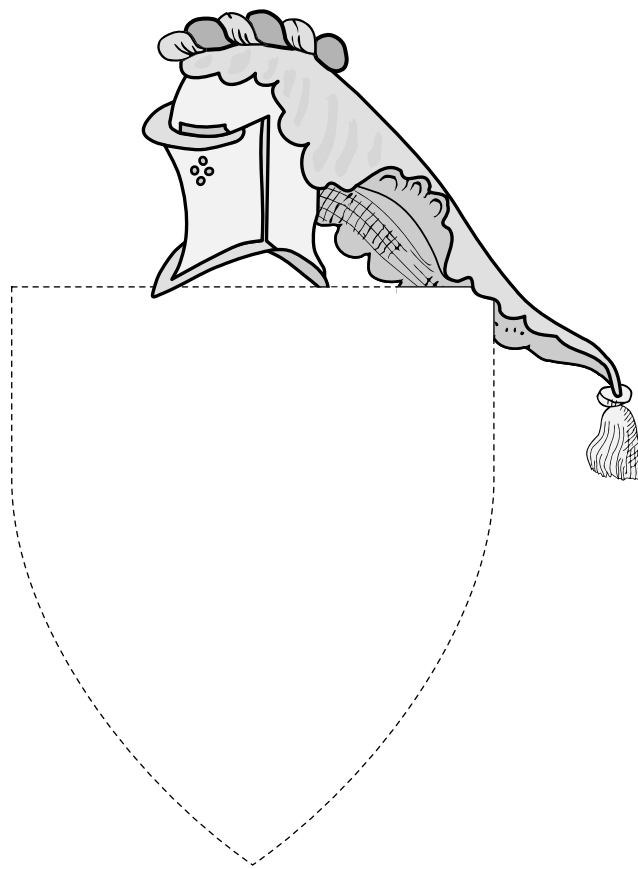

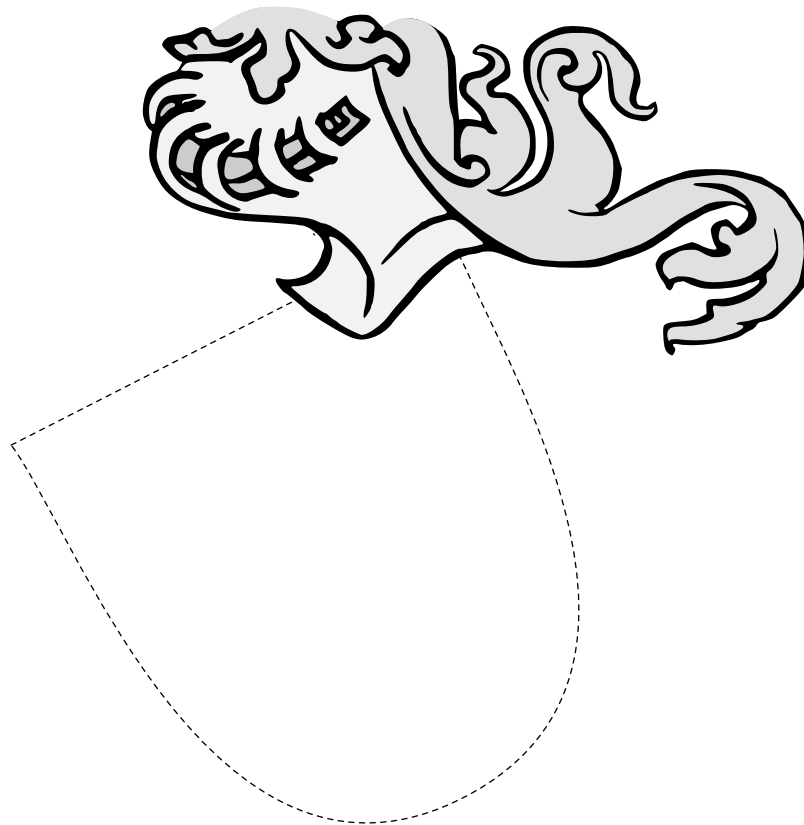

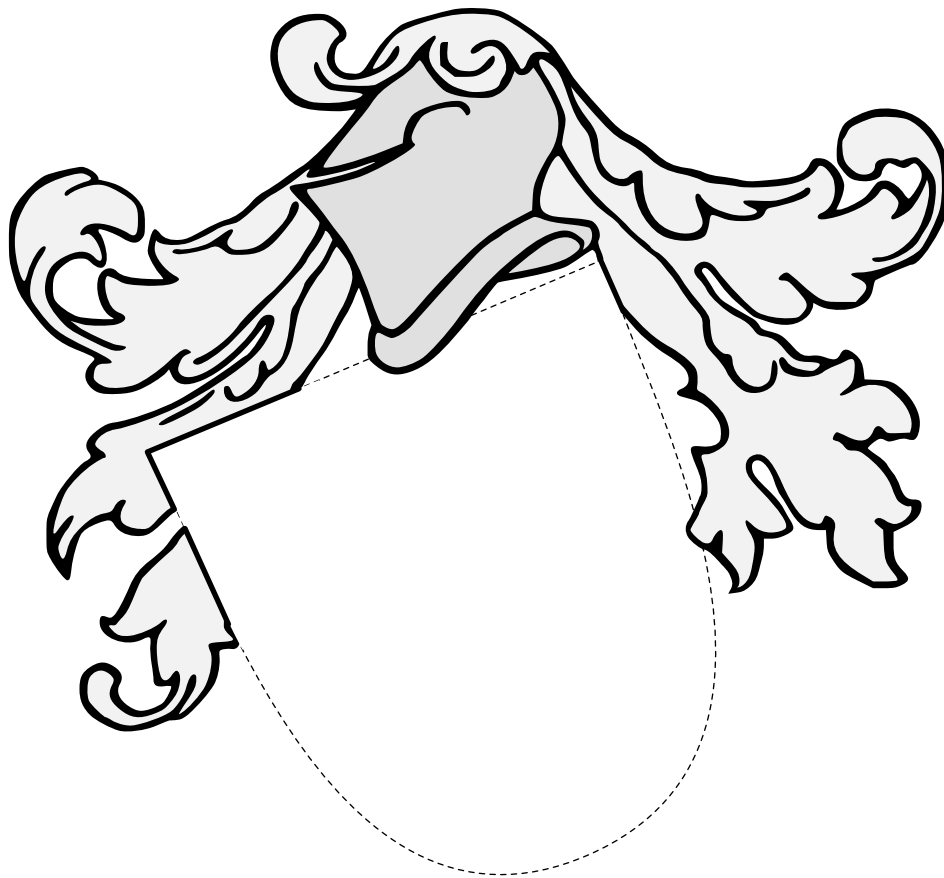

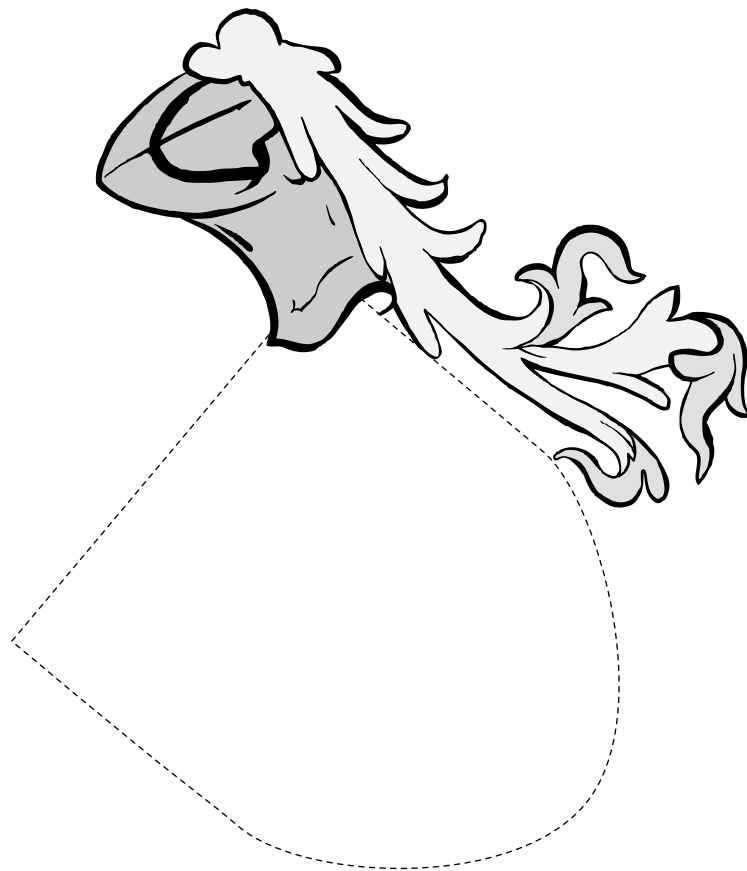

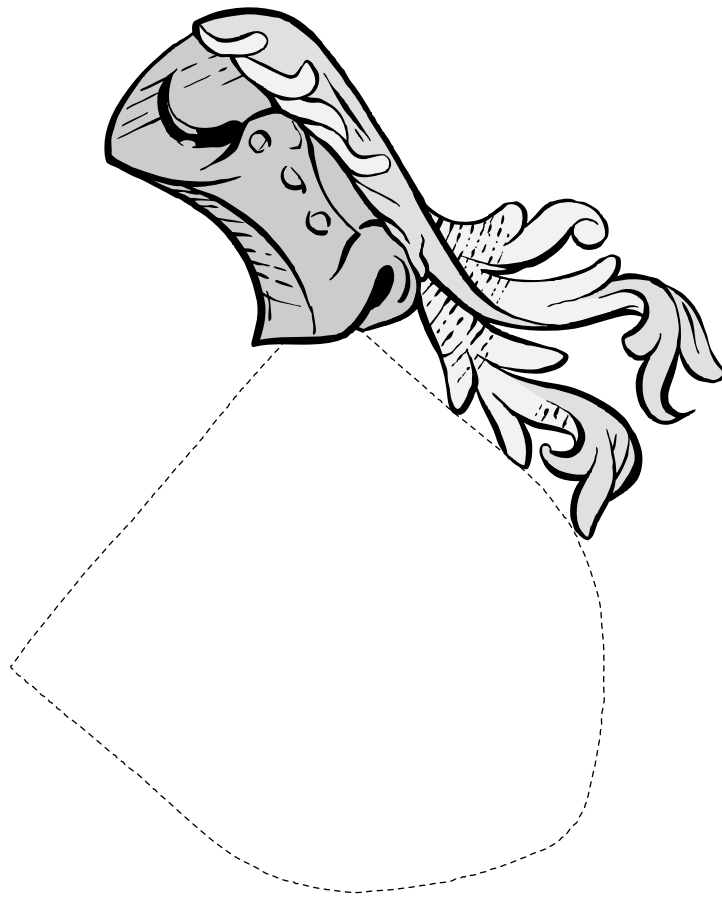

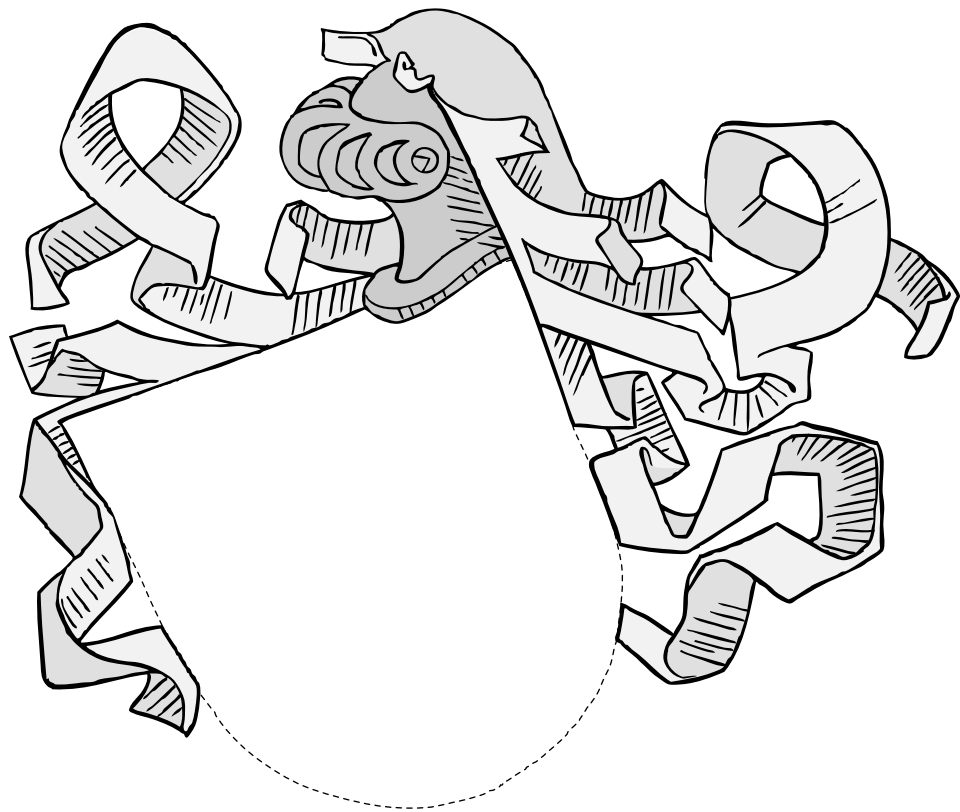

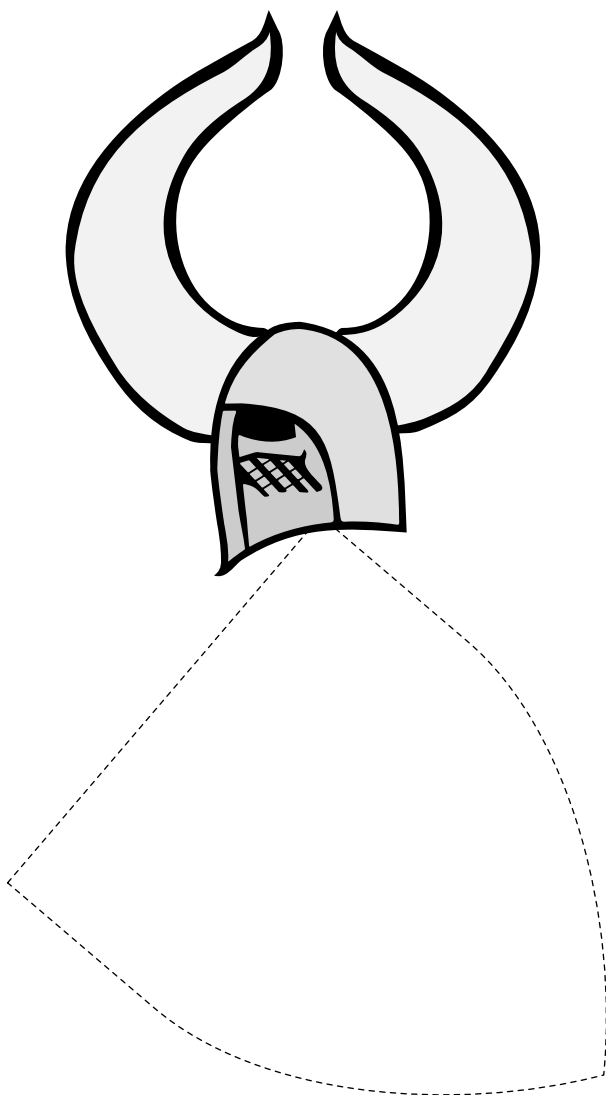

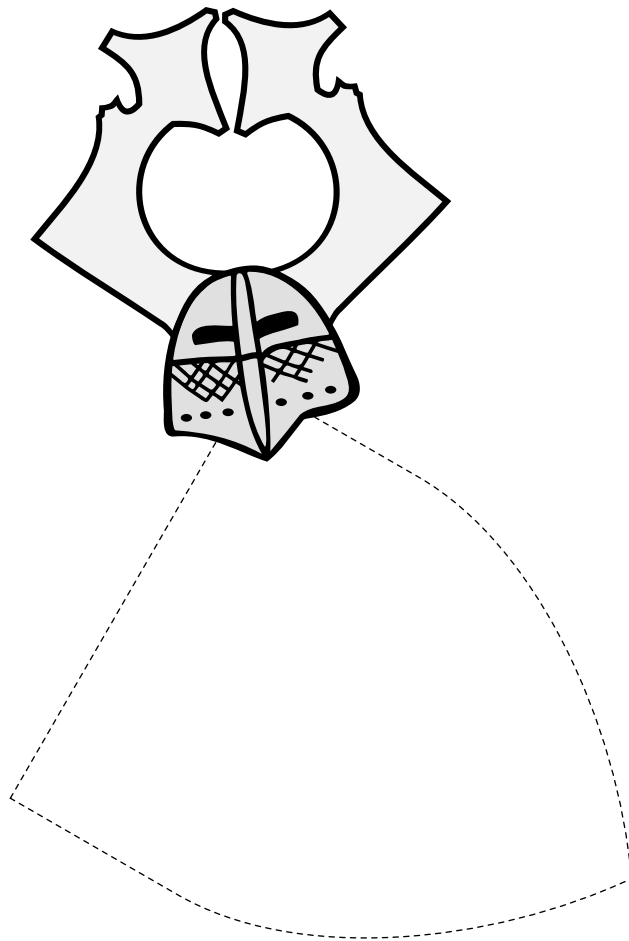

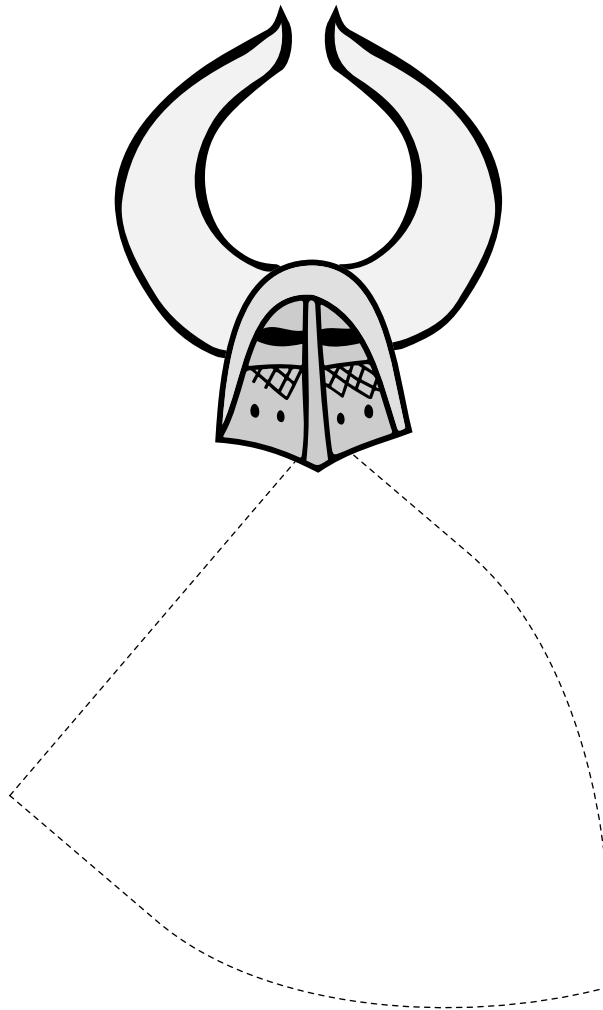

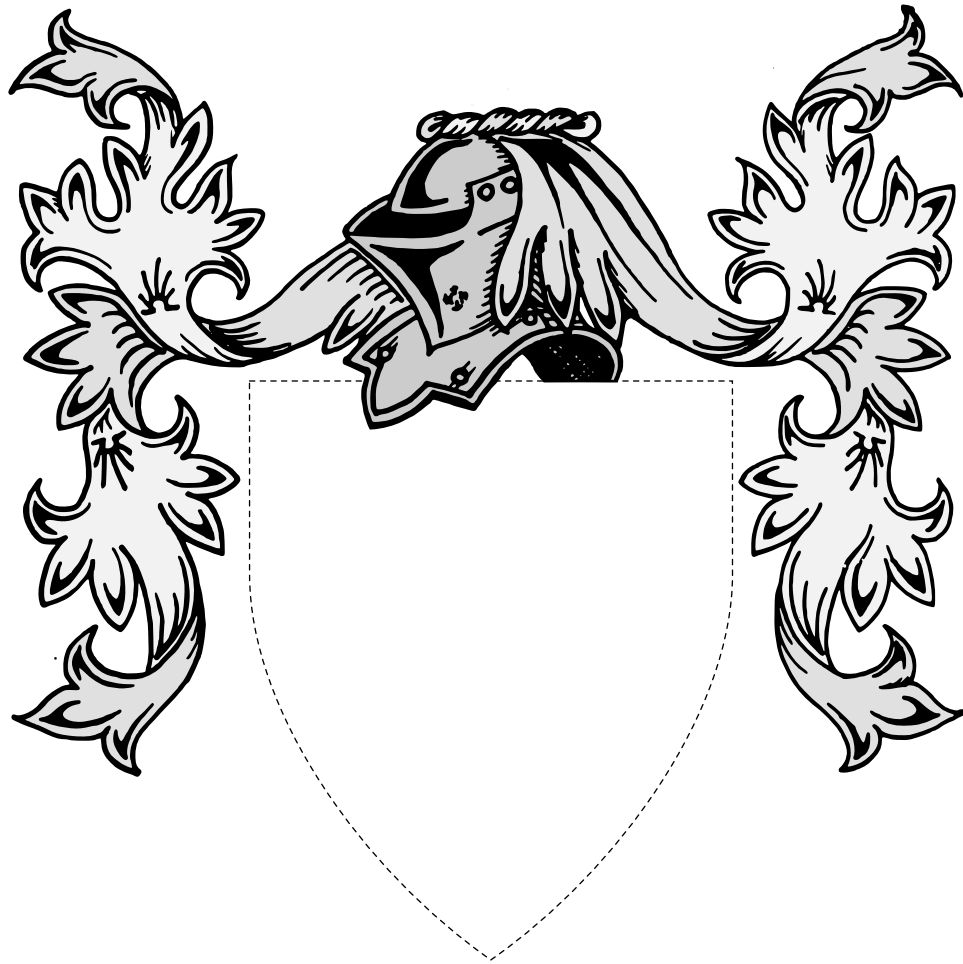

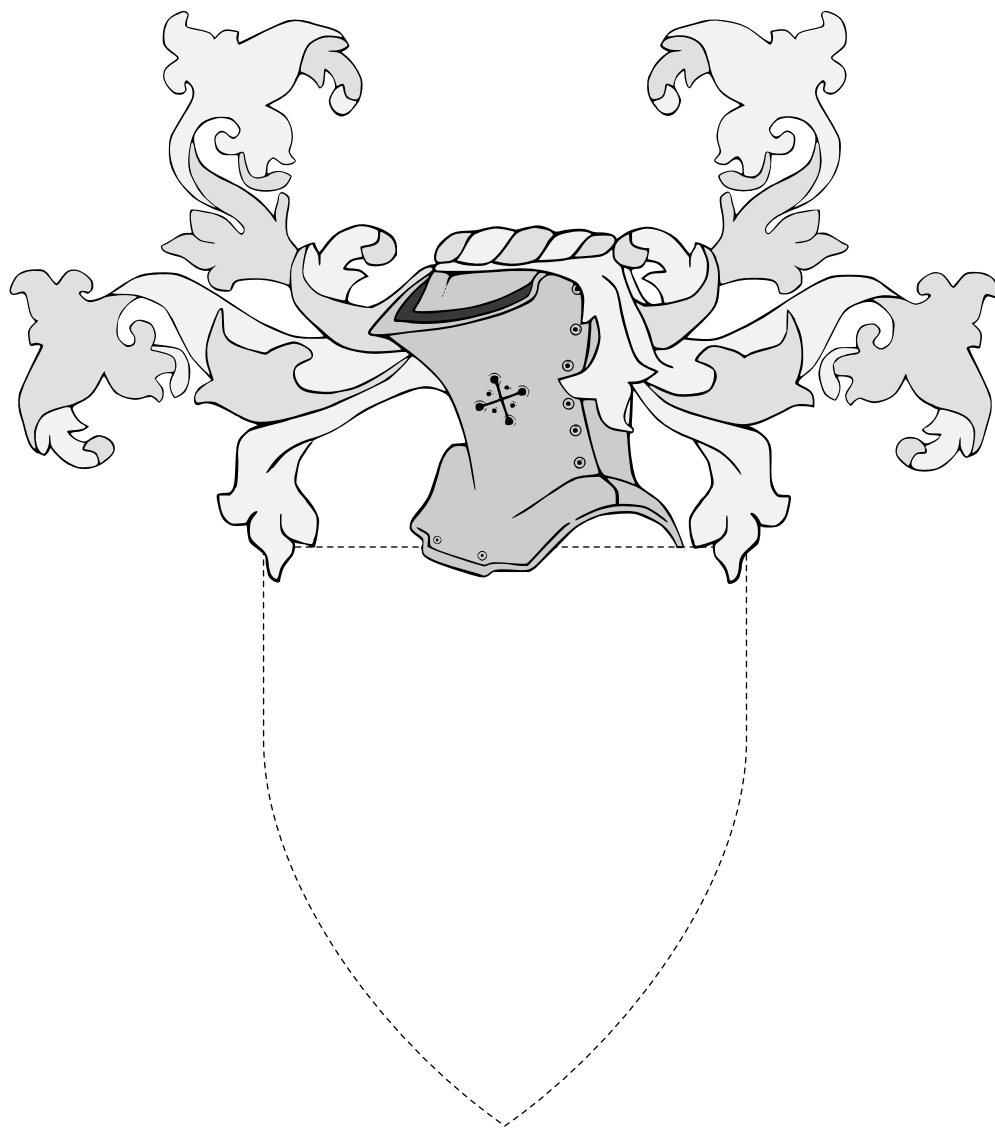

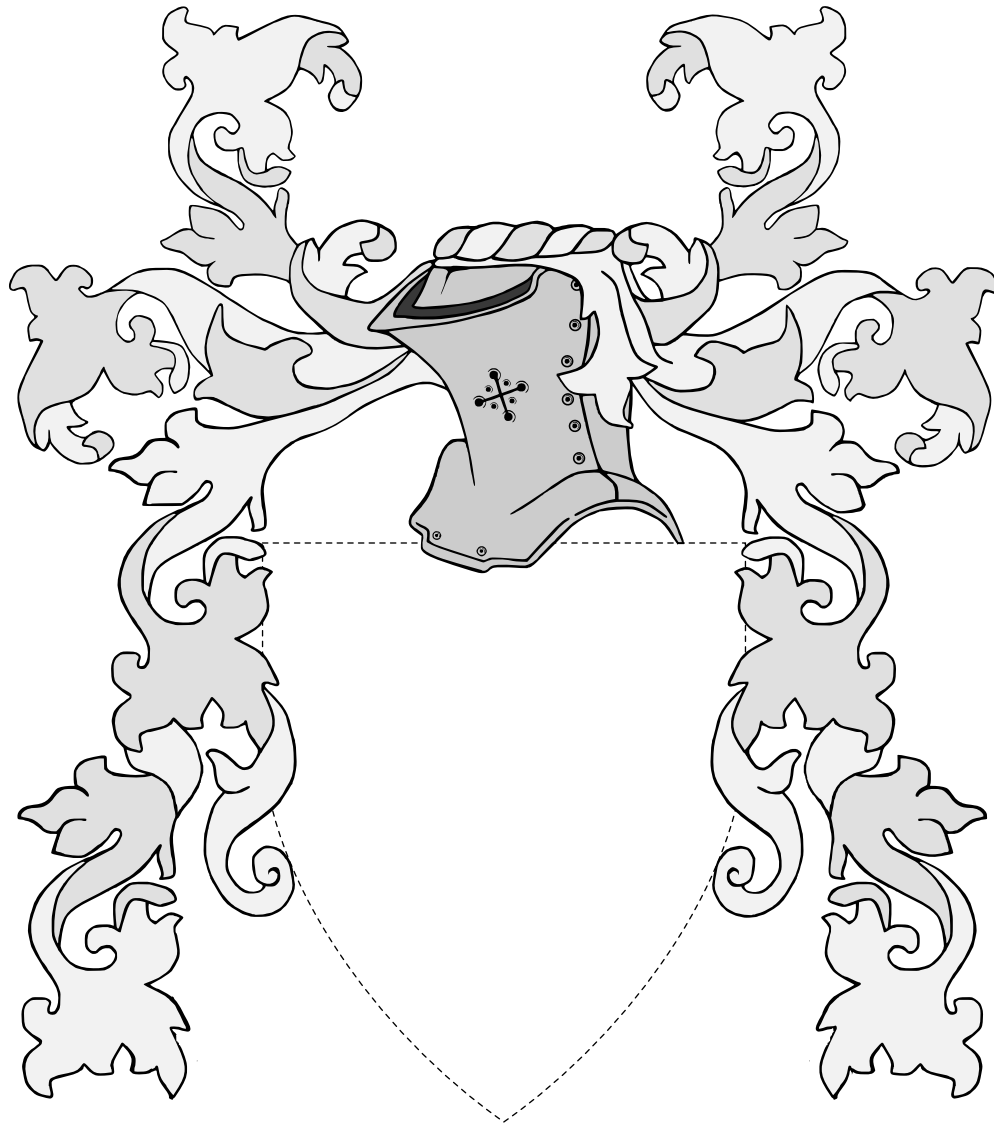

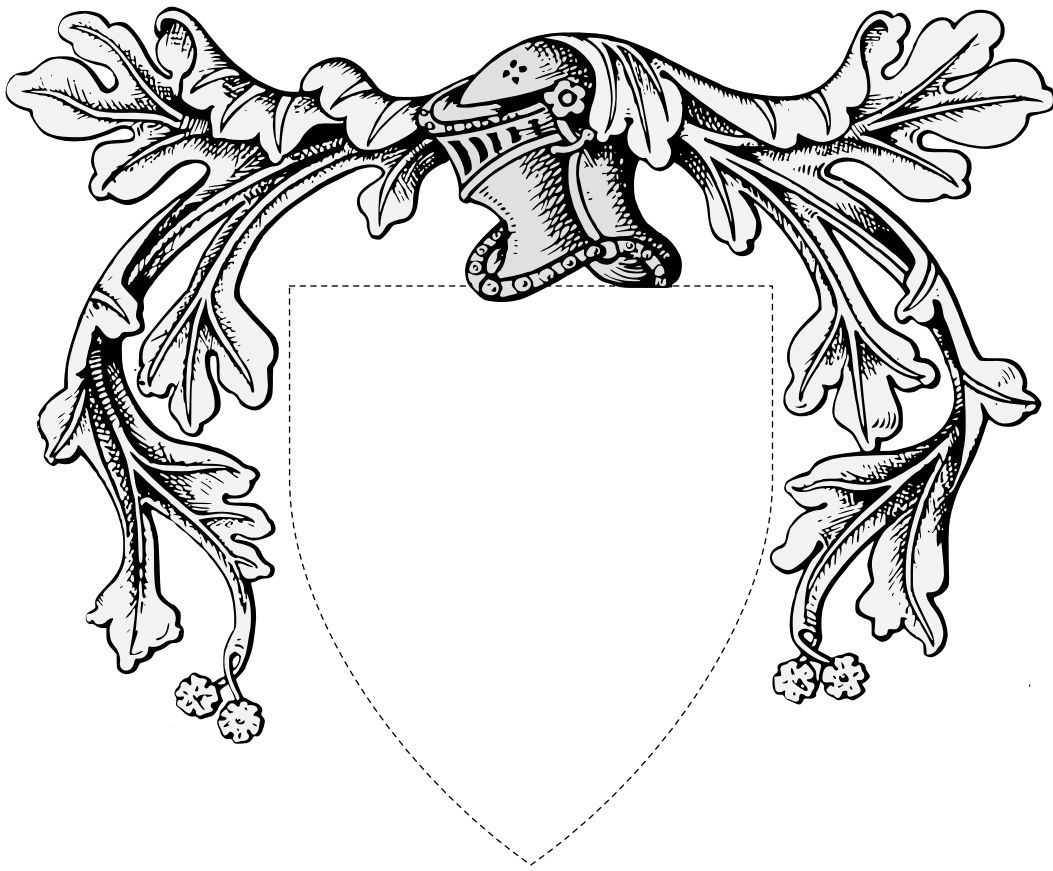

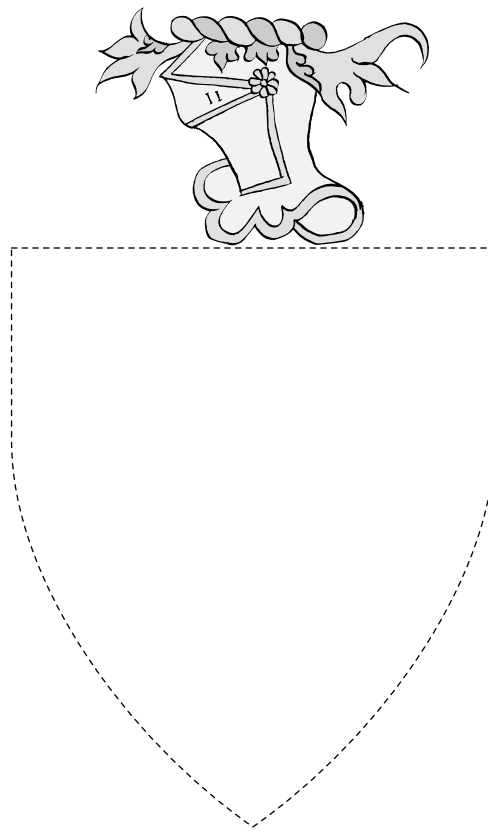

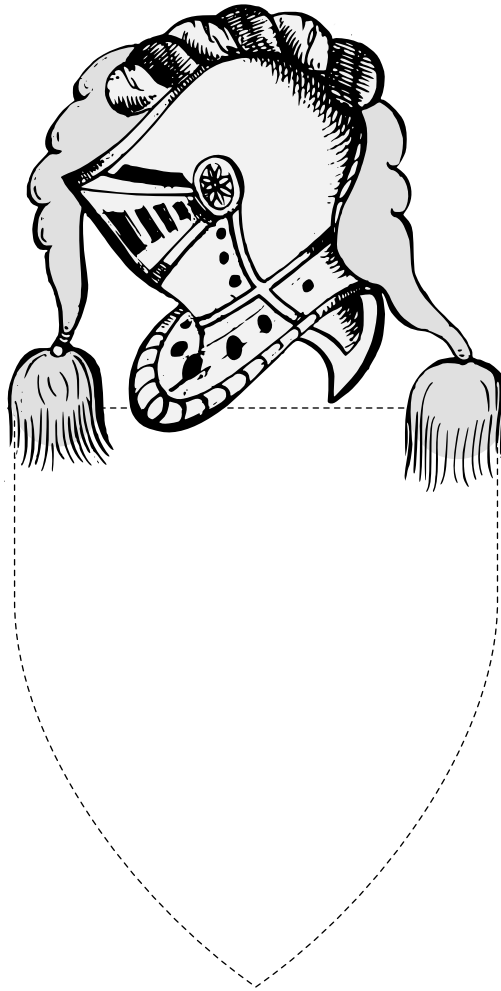

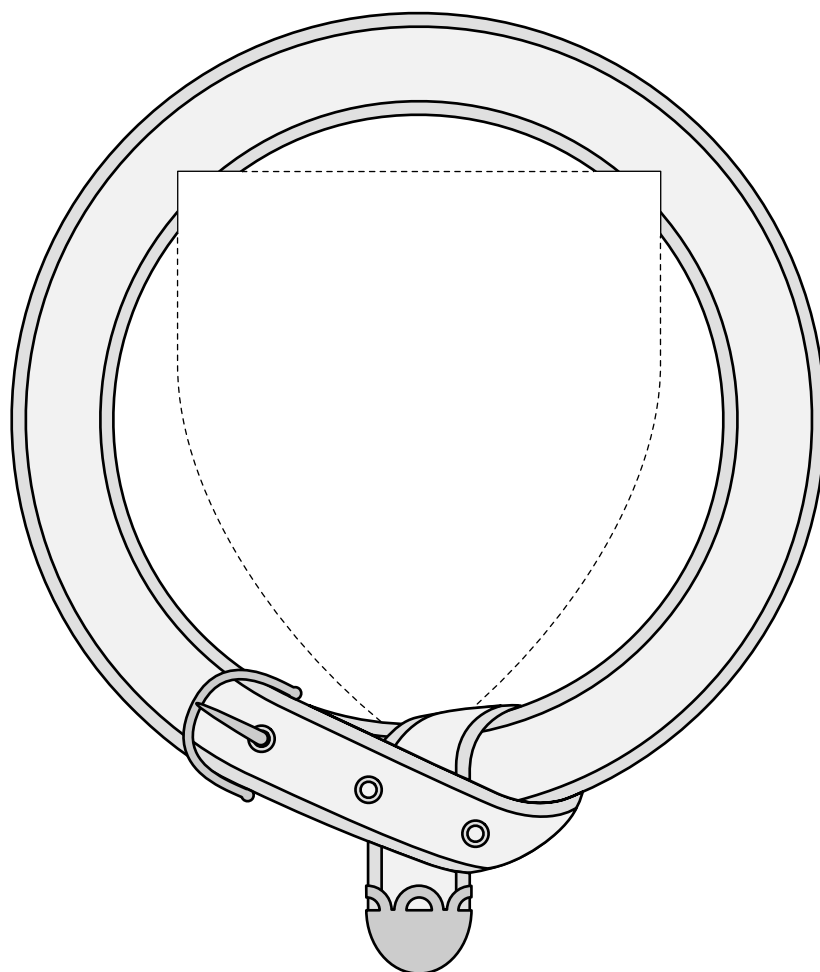

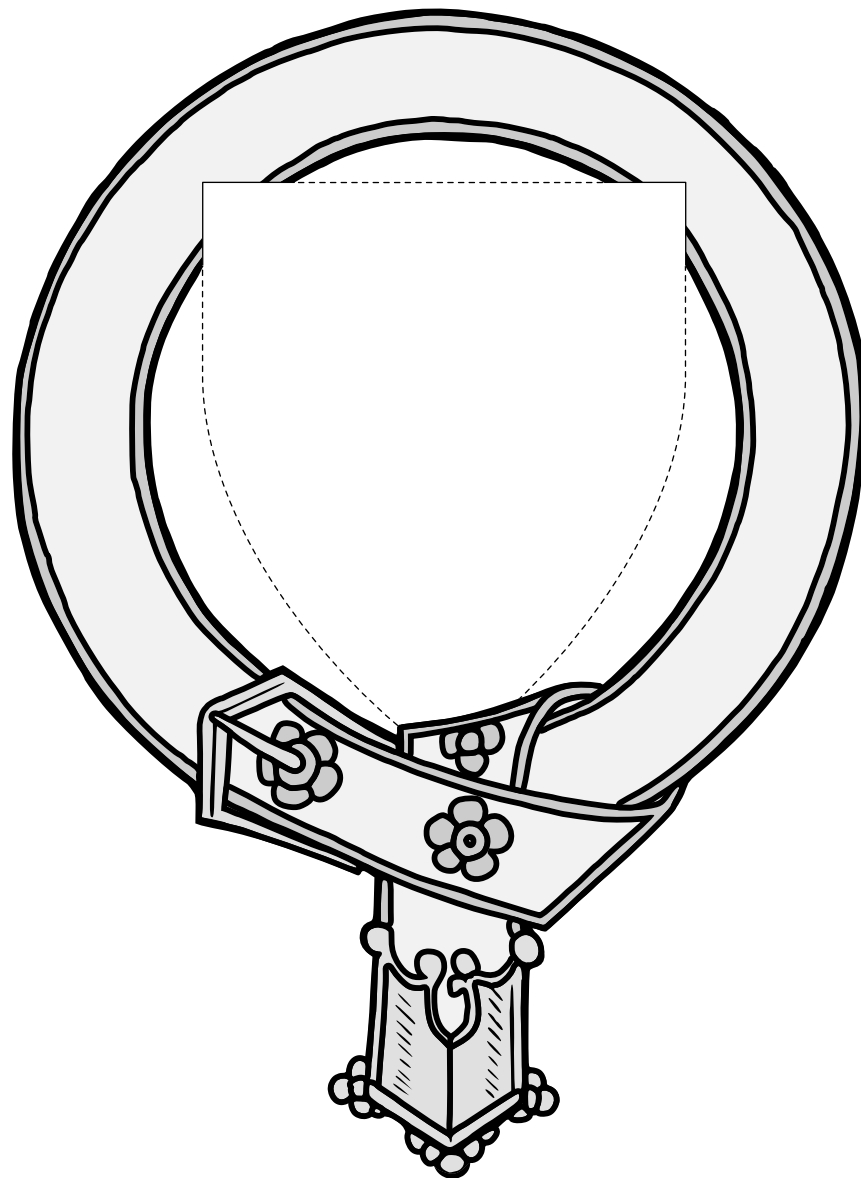

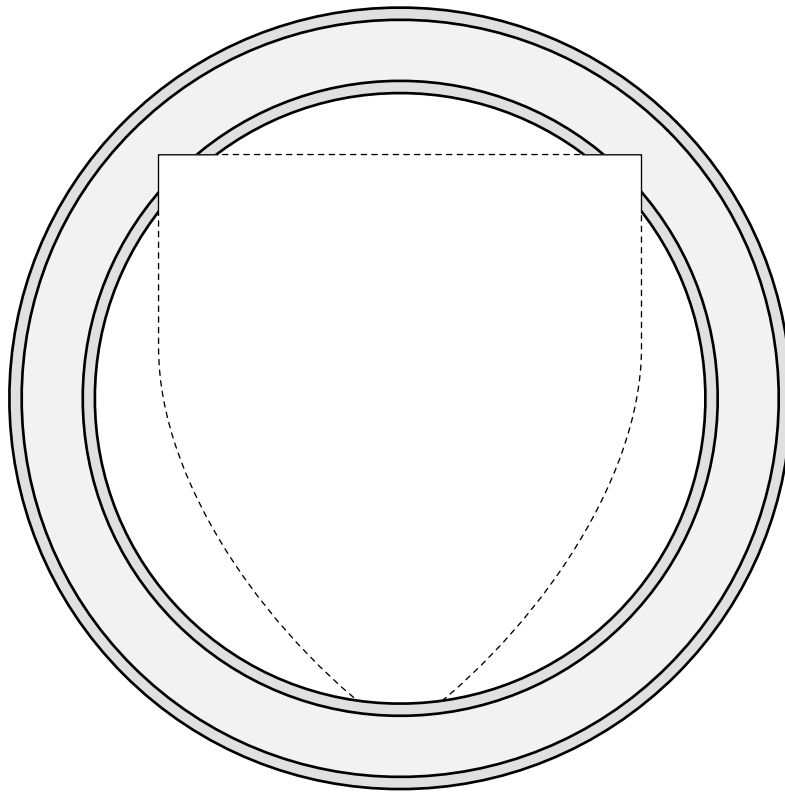

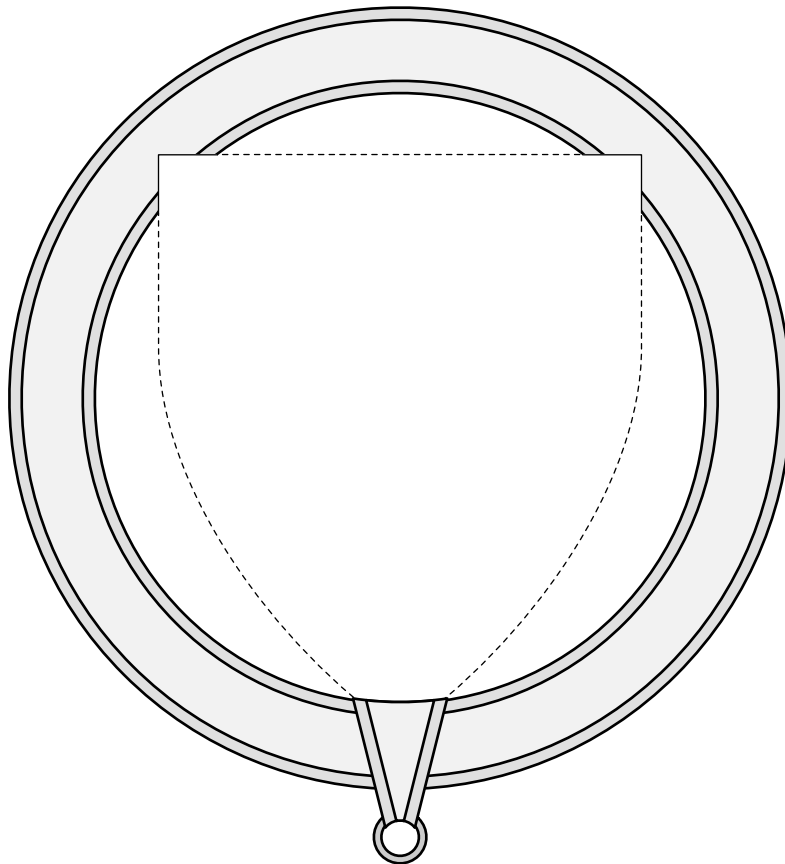

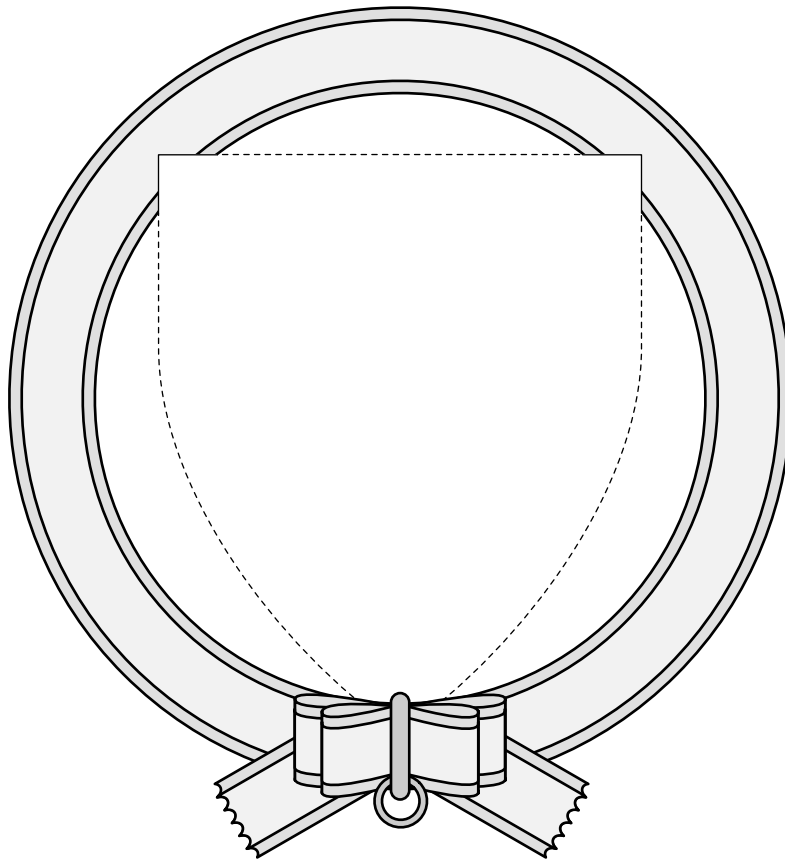

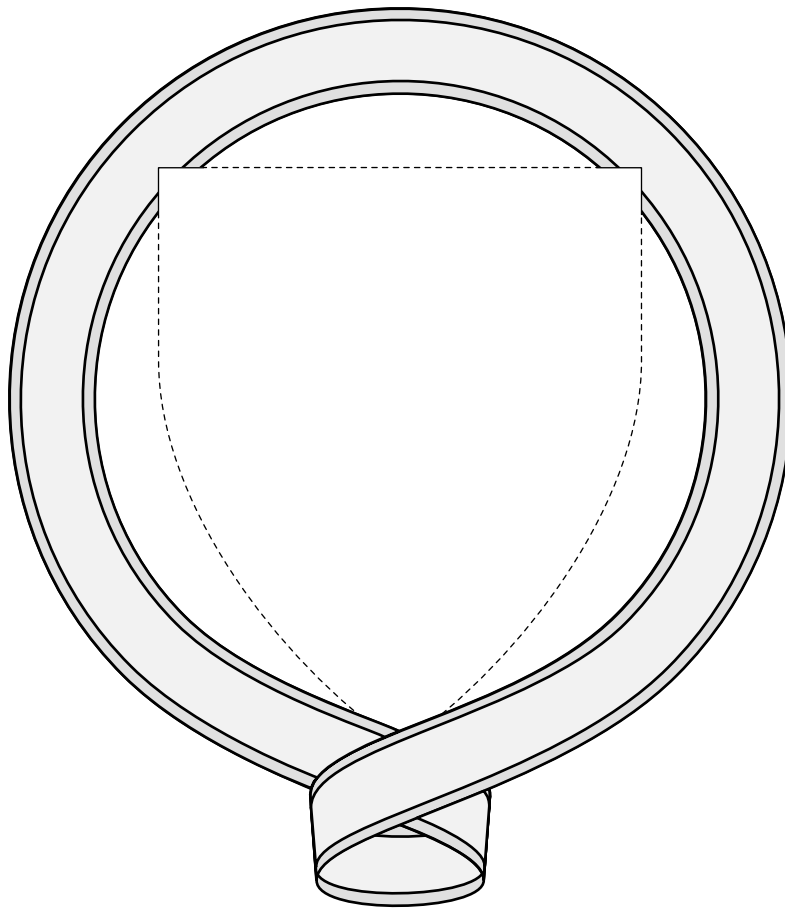

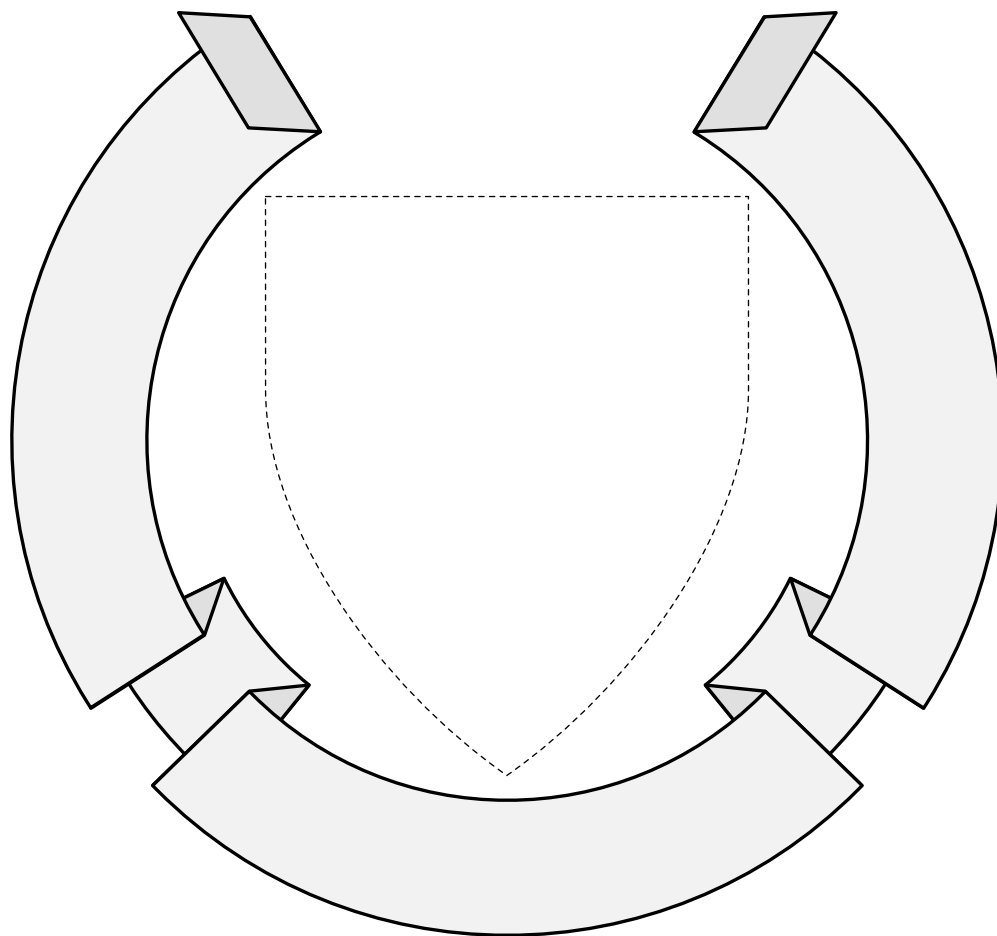

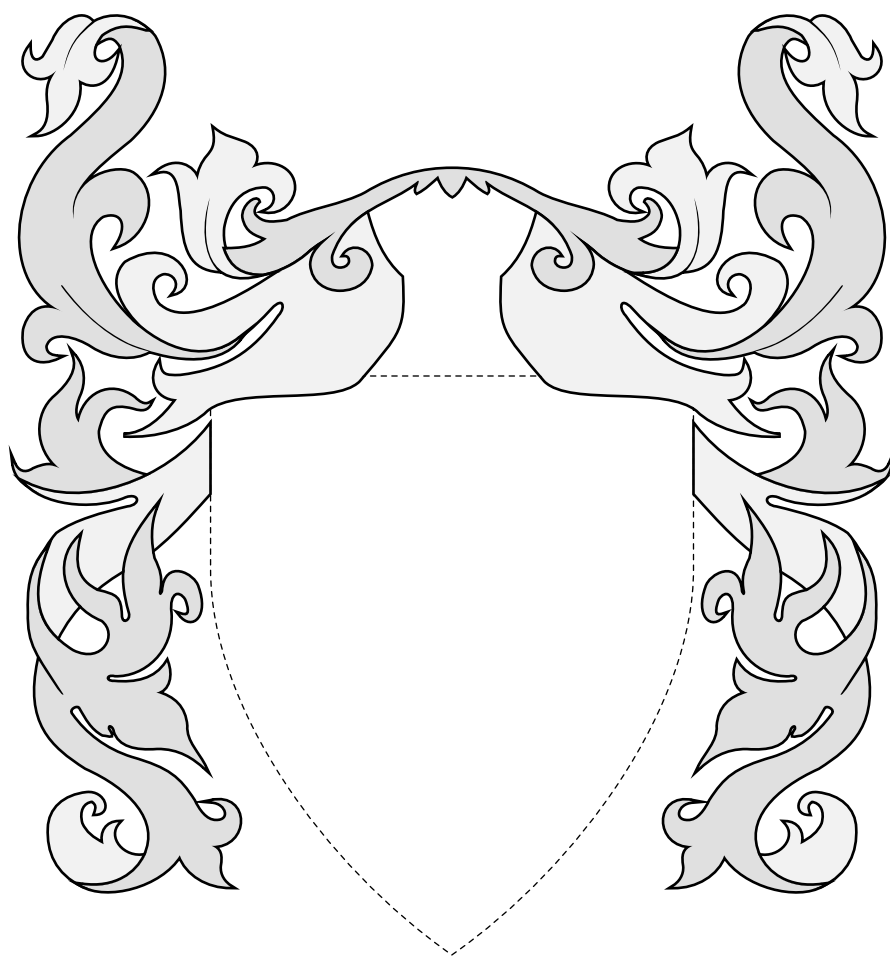

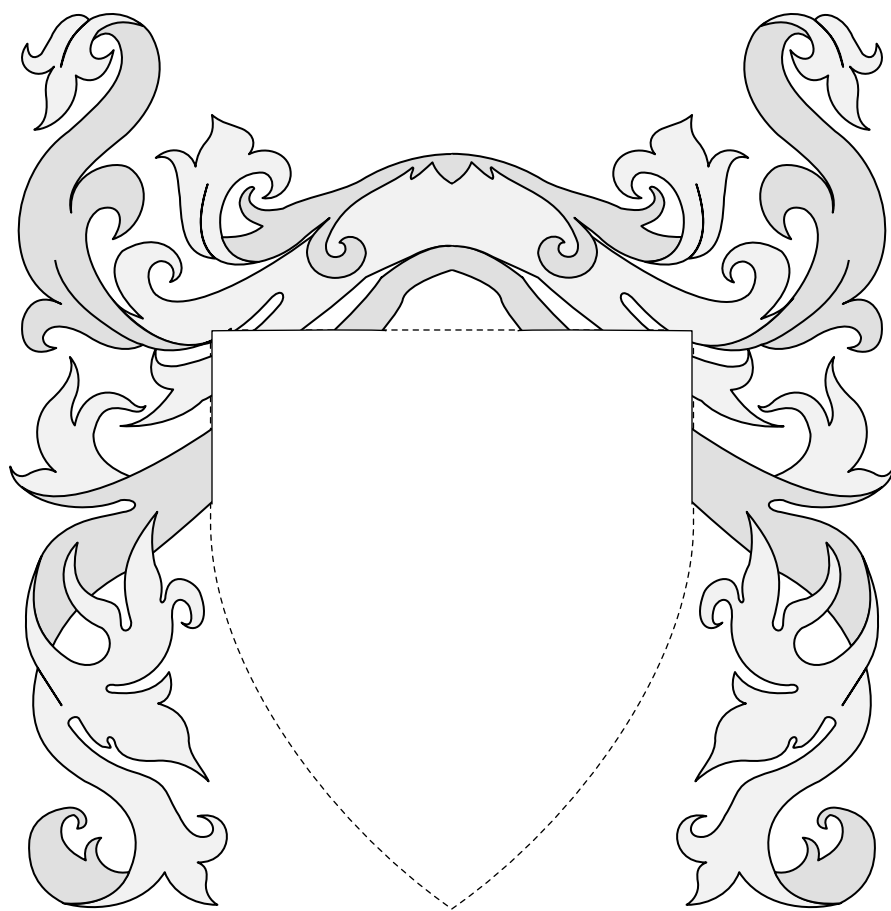

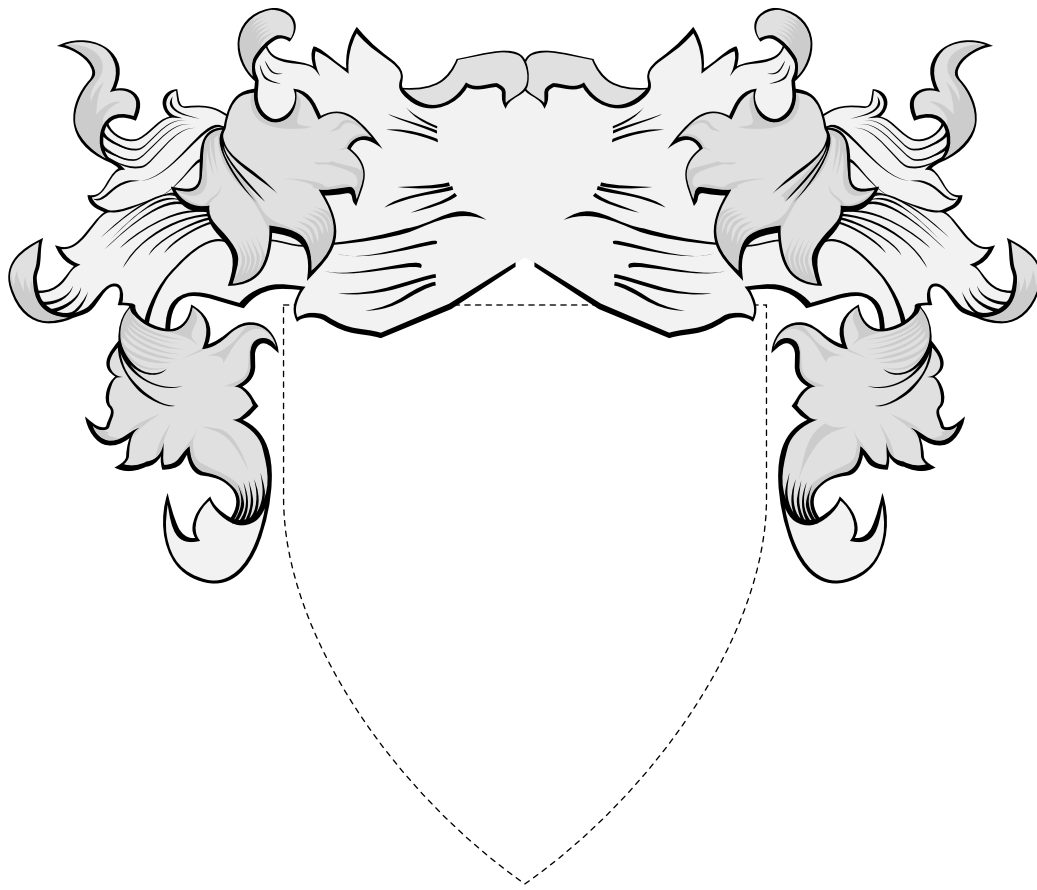

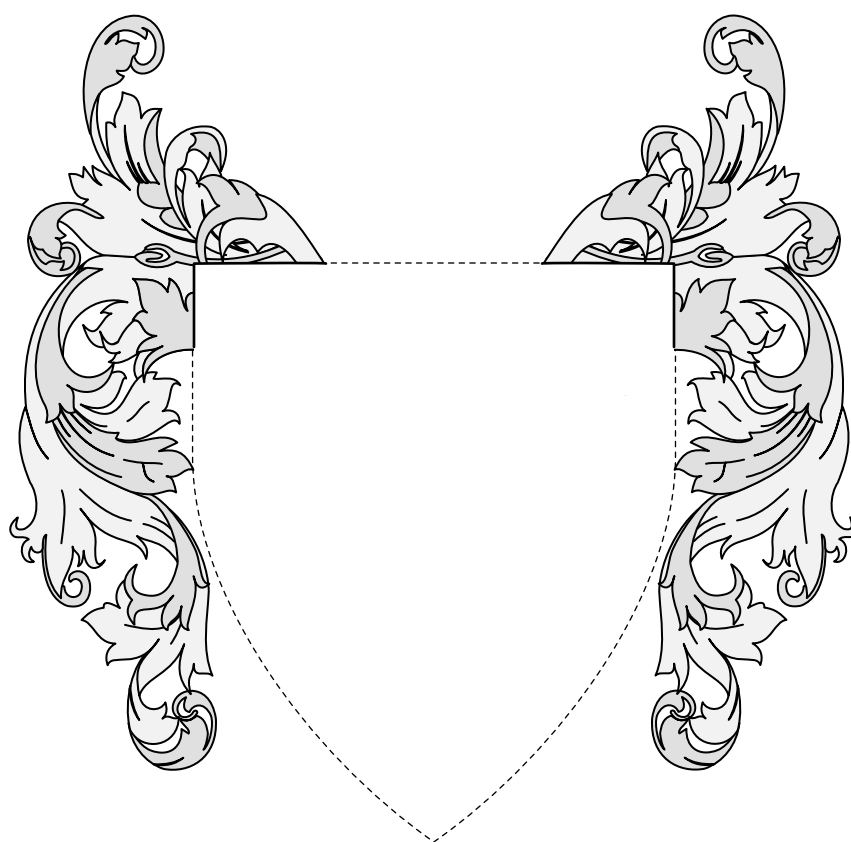
