



A piece of metal with hooks on each end used in architecture. In German heraldry it was known as a wolf-hook or "Wolfsangel."

Default orientation: palewise. No proper coloration.

Potentially offensive due to its use in the insignia of several Nazi groups and by modern white supremacists.
