



A drop of fluid. Sometimes spelled “gout.”

Typically blazoned by tincture, if argent a “goutte d’eau” (water), if Or “d’or”, if azure “des larmes” (tears), if gules “de sang” (blood), if sable “de poix” (tar), if vert “d’huile” (olive oil), if purpure “de vin” (wine).
