



A perennial flowering shrub known for its beauty and sharp thorns.

Default orientation: blossom affronty. Proper coloration: gules, barbed vert, seeded Or.

Wreaths, chaplets, orles and bordures of roses are reserved to queens, princesses, and companions of the rose. Crowned roses tinctured gules and argent (either doubled, quarterly, or per pale) are restricted as badges of the Tudors.

The March 2012 LoAR ruled that depictions of roses in profile, rather than affronty, are considered a Step From Core Practice (SFCP).
