Wolf's teeth are presented in several ways: as a field division, as straight or curving piles, or as naturalistic teeth.

Blazoned “*number* wolf’s teeth issuant from *side*.” May have three or four teeth, and may issue from dexter, sinister, base, all of which must be explicitly blazoned. (May also issue from chief, but this would be considered a Step From Core Practice.)
